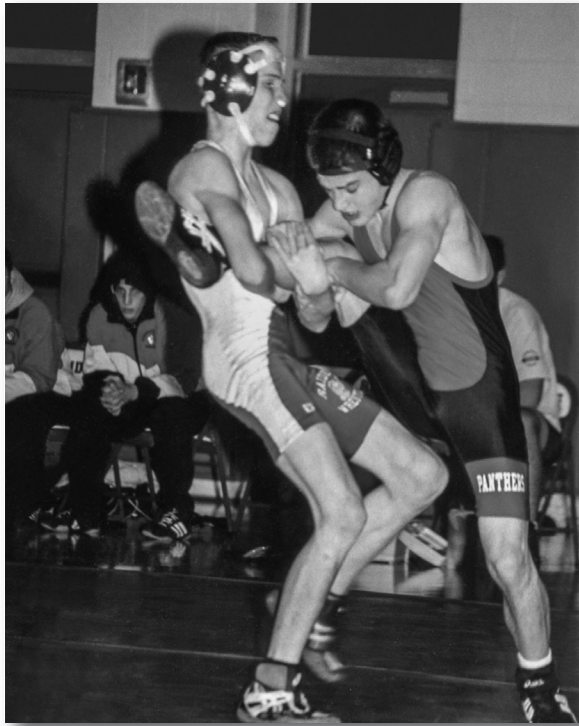


# Andrew Gewain



Andrew was a 4-year varsity letter winner that punished his opponents on the mat. During the seasons of 1999 to 2003, his overall career record was 101-18. He surpassed the 100-win mark, a feat accomplished by only 1 other wrestler at that time.

Andrew was a 2-time New Jersey State place winner finishing 6th in 2002 and 7th in 2003. He was a 3-time District Champion and was District runner up in his freshman year. Andrew won the Regional Championship in his senior year and was Regional runner up in the 2001 and 2002 seasons. He was a 4-time Somerset County Champion, only 1 of 3 wrestlers in Somerset County history to accomplish that feat at that time.

In the 2001 – 2002 season, Andrew finished in 5th place in Scholastic Press Coaches Association National Tournament. Andrew was a 3-time Champion at the Mount Olive Wrestling Tournament in the 1999-2000, 2001-2002, and 2002-2003 seasons. In his senior year, Andrew won the Outstanding Wrestler Award in this tournament.

Andrew was also a part of the teams that won the District Championships in the 2001 and 2002 seasons and the Somerset County Championship in 2002.

After college, Andrew served as a volunteer wrestling coach for Montgomery's youth recreation and high school teams. He was also a private coach for several athletes. In this position, Andrew coached multiple county, district, and region champions, as well as state place winners including a 2-time state champion and 3-time state finalist.
