

Parents wishing to drive their child to school between 7:00 and 7:30 AM can enter from:

(Arrows on the diagram indicate specific traffic routes from each campus entryway.)

Amwell Rd. Proceed directly into the <u>Staff Lot</u> (Do not use the "Horseshoe Driveway", as this is for buses only.) for student drop-off.

Then, exiting the <u>Staff Lot</u>, continue toward the <u>Amwell</u>
Road Exit. *Note: No left turns are permitted at that location


between 7:00 and 8:00 AM.

Road.

Raider Blvd. Enter North Driveway and proceed along the Amwell Road side of the building. Stop within the crosswalks for student drop-off. Proceed to the Amwell Road Exit (No left turns are permitted at that location between 7:00 and 8:00 AM). Also, students can be dropped-off in the North Parking Lot by entering that location through the entrance nearest Raider Boulevard. Exit this parking lot at the opening nearest Amwell

Homestead Rd. Enter the driveway nearest the <u>practice football field</u>. Proceed through the <u>South Student Lot</u> toward the <u>Media Center</u> for student drop-off. Continue around the cul-de-sac, then through the <u>South Student Lot</u> to exit the driveway nearest the <u>practice football field</u>.

Parents and students should not use the Front Driveway or the Staff Entrance at Homestead Road.



Authorized student drivers can enter from:

Amwell Rd. Turn left, and proceed into the North Student Lot.

Raider Blvd. Turn Right, into the North Student Lot and proceed to the

student parking area (west of the crosswalk that separates

student and staff parking areas).

Homestead Rd. Use the entrance nearest the practice football field and

proceed to the South Student Parking Lot.

<u>Parents and student drivers should not use the Front Driveway</u> or the Staff Entrance (at Homestead Road).

The North Driveway is for westward traffic only between 7 and 7:30 AM.
